Differences Between The 2018 Danish Norm and The Global Norm

The first column of the table above shows the scales on which people in the 2018 Danish norm group generally has a lower average raw score than people in the Global norm. This means that when scoring a profile, it will be more unusual to have endorsed a larger number of items when comparing to the Danish norm than when comparing to the Global norm, resulting in a higher score on the scale on the Danish norm.

The second column shows scales with small or inconsistent differences between the 2018 Danish norm and the Global norm. Even though there can be some differences between norms on these scores, they will likely not be very noticeable, and have little practical implications.
